WORK EXPERIENCE WEEK APPLICATION VIDEO CRITERIA

- **Maximum length 2 minutes.**
- **You MUST include the following points:**
 1. Introduce yourself. Your name, age and where you go to school.
 2. Why do you want to participate in Work Experience Week at STC?
 3. What skills and expertise do you wish to explore?
 4. What would be your dream job at a theatre company?
 5. What excites you about the future of theatre?
 6. Anything else about yourself that you think is interesting or important.
- **The video must be the applicant's own work.** You can use your friends or family as extras or get them to hold the camera, but you must be the director and the star!
- **The audio must be clear.** Make sure you are not speaking too softly and that we can hear everything you are saying.
- **Please film your video in landscape, not portrait.** This makes it easier for us to view!
- **The video must be uploaded online and a working link included in your application form before 5pm August 3.** Below we've provided links to a few handy instruction guides on how to upload a video to Vimeo or Youtube.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING YOUR VIDEO TO VIMEO

1. First, you'll need to join Vimeo [here](#). Make sure you and your parents read the [terms of service](#) before creating an account.
2. Vimeo provides its own [tutorial videos](#). The most important one for your application will be how to upload a video, however there are plenty of others you can check out so you are familiar with the site. Instructions on how to upload videos to Vimeo are located on the right-hand side under 'Tutorial Videos'.
3. Once you've uploaded your video, you may want to restrict who can view it. [Here](#) is an instructional video on how to password protect your video so only people with the password can view it. Password protecting your video is not compulsory, however if you do this remember to include the password when you submit your application.
4. Finally, copy and paste the URL from your video into the [Work Experience Application Form](#).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING YOUR VIDEO TO YOUTUBE

1. Sign in to [YouTube Studio](#) or create an account. Make sure you and your parent/guardian read the [terms of service](#)
2. In the top-right corner, click CREATE then Upload videos.
3. Select the file you'd like to upload. In the Select files to upload box, click "Public" and then choose "Private."
4. Once uploaded click the Visibility box and select Share privately.

5. Enter the emails you'd like to share your video with – education@sydneytheatre.com.au, then select SAVE.
6. Finally, copy and paste the URL from your video from YouTube into the [Work Experience Application Form](#).
